## DUTIES OF STATE CHAPLAIN

The State Chaplain shall:

- 1. Be responsible for the invocation and benediction at all State Meetings and Ceremonies.
- 2. Coordinate the Obituary reporting with the State Secretary and Chairman of the Resolutions Committee.
- 3. Maintain a current list of members who have passed away during the membership year and provide this list to the Chaplain General and the National Society Executive Director no later than April 1<sup>st</sup> each year, thus allowing the National Society ample time for printing the Necrology for the Congressional Memorial Service.
- 4. Develop and implement a formal Memorial Service to be used during the Annual Meeting.

Send a letter to accompany the formal resolution in memory of each deceased

Send a copy of the Congresssional Memorial Service Bulletin to the surviving spouse/family member accompanied by a letter.

Perform other duties which may be assigned to him by the State President or the Board of Governors.

5. Furnish the membership with spiritual guidance as required.
