## **DUTIES OF THE NATIONAL TRUSTEE**

## The National Trustee shall:

- 1. Attend and represent the Tennessee Society at two National Board of Trustees meetings normally held in Spring and Fall at the National Society Headquarters in Louisville, Kentucky and at the Annual National Congress which is held in June or July at a location determined by the National Board of Trustees.
- 2. Report the actions of the National Society's Board of Trustees to the Tennessee Society Board of Governors at their quarterly Board meetings (or at the Annual Meeting).
- 3. Bring issues of importance to the Tennessee Society before the National Society Board of Trustees for their deliberations.
- 4. As the highest nominated official of the State Society, work closely with the State President to maintain peace and harmony within the State Society.
