Duties of State Chancellor

The State Chancellor shall:

- 1. Advise the Board of Governors or the membership of legal matters that may affect the operations of the Tennessee Society.
- 2. Act as Parliamentarian for all State Society meetings. He shall also rule on interpretations of the Tennessee Society's Constitution and By-Laws.
- 3. Report to the National Chancellor General, when requested, on legal matters brought before the Board of Governors (or annual membership) meetings.
- 4. Perform other duties which may be assigned to him by the State President or the Board of Governors.
