TNSSAR Themes for Elementary School Poster Contest

The Tennessee Society Sons of the American Revolution (TNSSAR) announces the opening of the annual SAR Elementary School Poster Contest for TN Students prior to the start of each school year.

The word “student” is used to describe the person entering the contest. All 3rd, 4th, and 5th grade students interested in the American Revolution are invited to participate in the SAR’s Americanism Elementary School Poster Contest. The contest is open to public & private schools, parochial, home schooled, Scouting, or Children of the American Revolution member and any student in that same grade range. Young artists with an enthusiasm toward art, a love of American history, or a passion in creative expression can submit their posters to their local SAR chapter for competition.

The Themes for the school years are standard and set by the NSSAR. The noted years are school years within the America 250th Celebration window where organizations can be honored by TNSSAR in some manner as our “Partner in Patriotism”. The year in bold font is the next year in the series.

For academic years ending in even numbers the **Theme is “Revolutionary War Event or Events”**. (2015-2016, 2017-2018, 2019-2020, 2021-2022, **2023-2024**, 2025-2026, 2027-2028, 2029-2030, 2031-2032, 2033-2034).

For academic years ending in odd numbers the Theme is “Revolutionary War Person or Persons”. (2014-2015, 2016-2017, 2018-2019, 2020-2021, 2022-2023, 2024-2025, 2026-2027, 2028-2029, 2030-2031, 2032-2033).

The Theme for current school year **2023 to 2024** is **“Revolutionary War Event or Events”**.
