Duties of the Vice President

The Officer position within the TNSSAR is defined within the TNSSAR Constitution, Article IV - Officers.

The Duties of Officers are described in the TNSSAR By-Laws, Article VI - Duties of Officers and Committees.

Vice-President:

a. Shall perform duties as assigned by the President, and coordinate with the District Directors the planning and implementation of the goals and programs of the State Society.

b. Provide advice and direction to District Directors and to Chapter Presidents in regards to promoting growth, activities and development of Chapters and membership.

c. Shall work with the President and President-Elect to implement, coordinate and administer the programs and committee functions as requested.

d. Shall serve on the Membership and Extension Committee and in the absence of the President-Elect, preside over the Committee Meetings.

e. Shall be a member of the Honorary Membership Committee which is responsible for the administering the Honorary Membership program.

f. Shall preside over meetings and ceremonies of the State Society or Board of Governors in the in absence of the President and President-Elect.

g. Shall provide the President a written quarterly report of activities.
